Travel Bursaries and Abstracts: Application for travel bursaries and for submission of abstracts for presentation at SEA Fall Symposium "*Combating the 'fake news' epidemic – understanding and preventing the spread of misinformation*" are now open. Abstracts are solicited on any topic related to epidemiology. Students who submit an abstract and are chosen for oral or poster presentation, will have preference for receipt of a travel bursary. Following that, bursaries will be awarded in the order that a completed application was received.
