2. **Authors:** Last name, first name. First author listed should be the presenter. Please include the institution/organization affiliation of each presenter; degrees attained not necessary.
3. **Abstract format:** 300 word limit using the following headings:
 - Background and Rationale, Methods, Results, and Public Health Implications
