



Saskatchewan Epidemiology Association Spirit of the Profession Award

Terms of Reference

Purpose: To recognize an early career SEA member who has a positive impact on the field of epidemiology in Saskatchewan

Frequency: Awarded Annually

Criteria:

- The candidate is, or has been, a member of the Saskatchewan Epidemiology Association in the last three years
- The candidate must be actively contributing to the field of epidemiology in Saskatchewan.
- The candidate must be in good standing with the SEA and has demonstrated outstanding dedication and/or engagement and/or leadership in the field of epidemiology.
 - Dedication – The nominee has demonstrated unselfish dedication to the profession over and above personal interests
 - Engagement – The nominee has promoted learning opportunities and collaborative partnerships within the profession
 - Leadership – The nominee has demonstrated outstanding promotion of the profession and/or developed or new or innovative areas of research and/or translated epidemiological findings into the field of population health

Nomination Procedure: Any SEA member may make nominations. Nominations must be submitted to: saskepiassoc@gmail.com. Nominations must include:

- Name and contact information of the nominator
- Name and contact information of a seconder who would support the nomination
- Name and contact information for the nominee
- A completed nomination form

Deadline for submissions: September 20th each year

Nomination Procedure: Recipient selection is made by a SEA Board subcommittee based on the criteria outlined above

Presentation: Awarded annually at the annual SEA Annual General Meeting at the SEA Symposium. Award recipient will be contacted prior to the Symposium and invited to attend the awards presentation and to offer a brief response. Symposium registration will be complementary to both the Award Nominator and Award Recipient.

Form of Award: Monetary and token of appreciation
